Knox County Jail Awards Black Creek Contract to Retrofit Touchscreen Control System

Birmingham, AL – October 2, 2014 – Black Creek has been awarded a contract to retrofit the security control system at the Downtown Knox County Jail to a Black Creek [Super Display®](#) Touchscreen Security System. The jail is a 216-bed facility that opened in 1979 and is located in Knoxville, TN. Black Creek has worked with Knox County since 1994 when the Knox County Roger D. Wilson Detention Facility was built.

Black Creek will replace the existing control system with two Black Creek triple 32" touchscreen control stations. The project also includes furnishing and installing new server computers, control relays, and an intercom system.

The new Black Creek system will improve the safety of staff and visitors with its enhanced functionality that the current control system does not provide. Each Super Display® Touchscreen station features two LCD monitors that display all the facility's security controls and a CCTV camera call-up and video display. An officer can easily select different camera viewpoints, control facility utilities, and more. The system upgrade will make security control easier and save the facility money by decreasing maintenance costs and increasing staff efficiency.

Knox County Detention Center and Jail will both be standardized on Black Creek Systems upon project completion.
